

Key Vocabulary:

- ◆ Mode of transport - a method or way of travelling
- ◆ Journey - the act of travelling from one place to another
- ◆ Departure - the action of leaving, especially to start a journey
- ◆ Landmarks - anything that is easily recognizable, such as a monument, building, or other structure
- ◆ Destination - the place to which someone or something is going or being sent
- ◆ Expenditure - the action of spending funds
- ◆ Fare - the money paid for a journey on public transport

Preparing to make a journey:

- ◆ choose and wear clothing appropriate for the weather
- ◆ find out the cost of the trip
- ◆ take sufficient money to cover the fare and other possible expenditure
- ◆ take your mobile phone or correct change for a pay phone
- ◆ take phone number of an emergency contact with you
- ◆ confirm journey details with driver or transport employee
- ◆ buy ticket and check change.



When making a journey, remember:

- ◆ use familiar landmarks to check journey progress, as appropriate
- ◆ leave transport safely at destination
- ◆ continue journey, as appropriate
- ◆ know where to get help if required
- ◆ use appropriate language to ask for help if required
