Teamwork –	Working together to reach a shared goal.
Listening –	Paying attention to others when they speak.
Respect –	Treating others kindly and valuing their ideas.
Responsibility –	A task or duty that someone is expected to do.
Shared Goal –	A goal that a group works together to reach.
Goal –	Something you aim to achieve.
Collaboration –	Cooperating with others by sharing ideas, tasks, and responsibilities.

How to Be a Good Team Member:
 Listen carefully to others.
 Share your ideas politely.
 Take turns and share tasks fairly.
 Encourage others and celebrate their efforts.

Setting and Sharing Goals:
 A team agrees on a goal.
 Everyone helps to plan how to reach it.
 Each person may have different jobs, but all work towards the same end.

Dealing with Challenges:
 Talk calmly if there's a disagreement.
 Think about how others feel.
 Find solutions together.

Key Vocabulary

Respect –	Treating others how you would like to be treated.
Opinion –	What someone thinks or feels about something.
Idea –	A thought or suggestion about how to do something.
Confidentiality –	Keeping something private or secret when asked to.
Trust –	Believing that someone will do the right thing.
Empathy –	Understanding how someone else feels.
Listening –	Paying attention to someone when they are speaking

What I will know by the end of the unit:

Understand what respect means and how I can respect others.

Respect means:

Listening without interrupting.

Not laughing at or mocking someone's opinion.

Saying, "I see your point," even if you disagree.

Confidentiality means:

If someone shares something personal or private, don't tell others unless someone is in danger.

Keep secrets that are safe and appropriate.

It's okay to disagree, but do it kindly.

Skills to Practise

Listening carefully without interrupting.

Using respectful phrases like:

"I see it differently, but I understand your view."

"That's an interesting idea."
