Key Vocabulary	
God	A being that is worshipped and believed to have special powers over nature or life.
Bible	A collection of books made up by two parts – the Old Testament and New Testament.
Christianity	The large group of religions who believe that the son of god was born a man - Jesus - over 2000 years ago.
Special	Having a particular purpose or use.
Belief	A strong opinion - an idea accepted as true.
Book	Work of literature, such as a novel or a volume of poetry.
