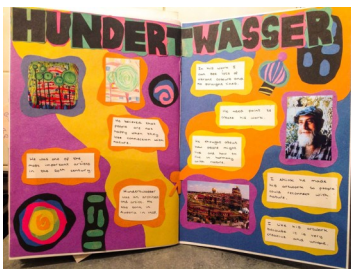
**Friedrich Hundertwasser** was an Austrian -born New Zealand artist and architect who also worked in the field of environmental protection.

**Sgraffito** is a technique where potters can put a layer of glaze or slip on a piece of pottery, let it dry, then use a pottery carving tool to scratch at it to show the base layer of colour. Sgraffito derives from an Italian word meaning “to scratch.”
