Wayne Thiebaud is an American painter. He was born on November 15th 1920.

At high school, he became interested in how theatre stages were designed and lit. As a teenager, he got a summer job working in the animation department of Walt Disney Studios.

From 1939, he worked as a cartoonist, a sign painter and an illustrator before going back to college to study art.

During the 1950s, he visited New York City. This inspired him to try a new art style. Wayne began painting pictures of everyday things and tasty treats, such as cakes, gumball machines and make-up. 'Cakes' was painted with thick oil paint to look like



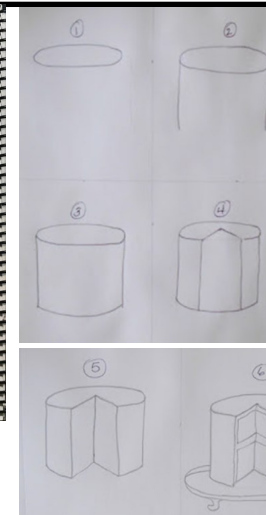
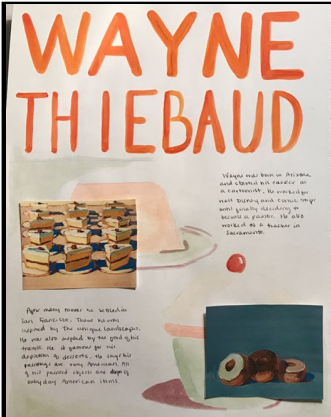
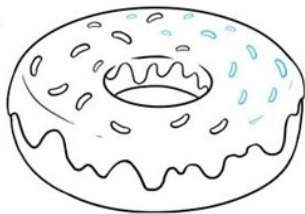
