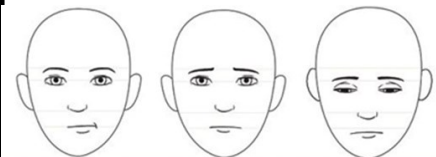
Erich Heckel was a German painter / printmaker, and a founding member of the group Die Brücke (which means The Bridge) 1905 to 1913.

Die Bruke created the style of art known as Expressionism. The artists who belonged to this group believed art should be about making the viewer feel emotions, rather than the work being a perfect image of something. Heckel was especially interested in showing human expression and emotion in his artwork.

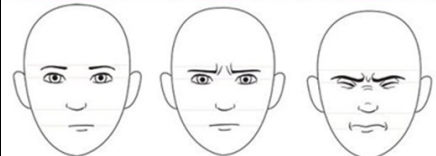

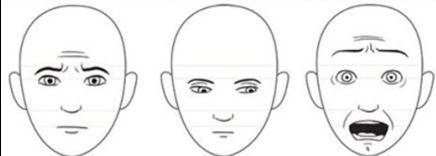


Distressed Crying Pain

Relief Printmaking: Etching an image onto foam board and then applying ink to make a print.

Mono-printing: Drawing directly on a surface to produce a single print.
