Key Vocabulary	
Keyboard	A musical instrument played by pressing a variety of notes.
Notes	A notation representing the pitch and duration of a musical sound.
Five-Finger Technique	A technique to play the keyboard with all five fingers of the hand.
Instruments	A device created or adapted to make musical sounds.
Musical Elements	Elements that help to enhance a piece of music (rhythm, pitch, tempo, timbre, dynamics etc).
