Singing	The activity of performing songs or tunes by making musical sounds with the voice.
Genre	A style or category of music.
Melody	A sequence of single notes that is musically satisfying
Diction	The style of enunciation in speaking or singing.
Musical Elements	Elements that help to enhance a piece of music (rhythm, pitch, tempo, timbre, dynamics etc).
Ensemble	Two or more performers playing an instrument or singing together at the same time.
